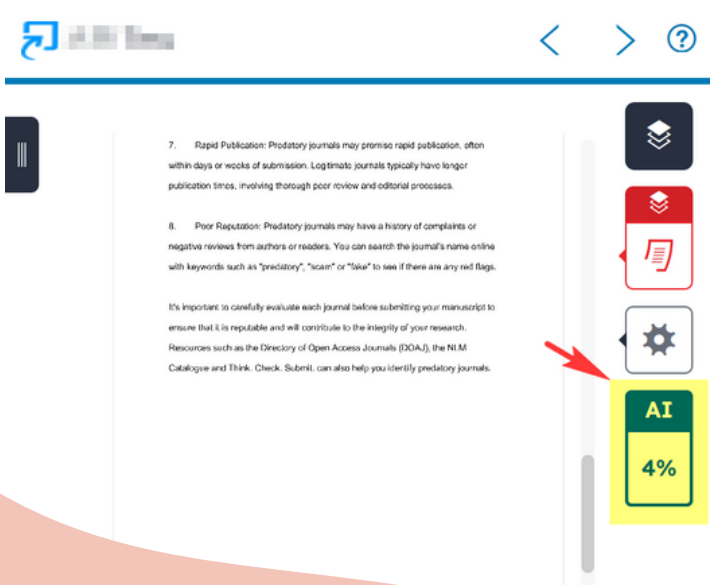

Only for instructor account

Student account cannot access the AI detection report.



Only work for content submitted in English



Long-form writing only

It doesn't reliably detect in short-form writing such as bullet points, tables, or annotated bibliographies.



Can detect GPT-3/3.5 and ChatGPT signatures
Keeping pace with evolving AI writing technology.



NOT 100% accuracy.

It does not take into account any text within the document that is not considered long-form prose.
